#### DECLARATION OF FSM & CERT FORMATION STATUS

- 1 This notification serves to inform you that the above mentioned premises is required to appoint a Fire Safety Manager (FSM) and Company Emergency Response Team (CERT) comprising at least 6 members.
- 2 The Fire Safety (CERT) Regulations 2013 came into operation on 1st September 2013. Under the new regulations, the owner or occupier of any premises specified in the Fire Safety (Premises Requiring FSM and CERT) Notification 2013 are required to establish a CERT by 1st March 2014.

3 In order to allow sufficient time for premises to comply with the CERT regulations, an additional grace period of 25 months is given to CERT premises from 1st March 2014. Audits for CERT premises has started on 1st April 2016. A CERT audit notification will be sent to you approximately one month before the scheduled date for the CERT audit.

#### SCDF has given sufficient grace period

- ✓ Will start taking enforcement action on premises without FSM / CERT
- ✓ Penalty up to \$10000 fine and 6 months imprisonment if convicted in court



- Contact SCDF at <u>SCDF CERT@SCDF.GOV.SG</u> immediately if you have not updated SCDF on your FSM and CERT status.
- Notices of Fire Safety Offence will be issued to premises without CERT from October 2016.

#### **CERT** audit checklist

- Must pass both documentation and practical audits to pass CERT audit
- Greater emphasis on CERT manpower, training and equipping
- Greater emphasis on proper evacuation procedures and supporting SCDF

- Current CERT Structure (2016)
  - √ 1 x Site Main Controller (SMC)
  - ✓ 1 x Site Incident Controller (SIC)
  - ✓ 4 x Response Team Members (ERT Members)
    - Fire trained
- These are minimum requirement, larger or riskier premises should consider having a larger CERT if possible.



- CERT Structure (By 31 March 2018)
  - √ 1 x Site Main Controller (SMC)
  - ✓ 1 x Site Incident Controller (SIC)
  - ✓ 4 x Response Team Members (ERT Members)
    - Fire trained
  - √ 4 x Response Team Members (ERT Members)
    - First aid trained
- Can be same or different persons to be trained (refer to CERT structure)





By 2018, there must be a minimum of 4 trained first aiders in a CERT. The certification is valid for 2 years (NRC requirement). Accepted first aid courses should cover basic first aid, as well as CPR & AED.




- Accepted first aid certifications:
  - ✓ WSQ Perform Workplace First Aid (with CPR and AED)
  - ✓ Occupational First Aid with CPR and AED
  - ✓ Standard First Aid with CPR and AED
  - ✓ Basic First Aid with CPR and AED
  - ✓ Equivalent first aid courses that adequately covers the topics
- Non-accepted first aid certifications:
  - X Basic First Aid with only CPR or AED
  - X Community Emergency Preparedness Programme
  - X First Aid orientation / introduction / awareness courses






## **CERT Structure (OK)**










